Water Pollution Control Update

- **Plant**

- Preparation for 2024's disinfection season completed. UV system is online. Laboratory IDEXX QA/QC testing completed.
- Follow up meeting occurred with the OEPA on 4/16/24 to discuss outfall relocation proposal. Schedule of compliance timeline was the main topic of conversation. Draft NPDES permit for our facility should be sent out by OEPA very soon. GPD is going to begin survey work on site at Kinder Morgan in preparation of the outfall relocation.
- April 5th – MH Equipment completed tow motor certification and training at the wastewater plant.
- Ohio Department of Health had a COVID sampling update meeting on 4/16/24. Monday and Wednesday influent wastewater sampling continues. Information on the data obtained can be found at:

- Working to obtain pricing for Bridge and Morton replacement pump.
- Minnesota storm water pump station has a failed vacuum pump. We are in the process of procuring a replacement.

- GPD Study is still ongoing. This includes the short/long term capital improvement plan, sewer rate study, and SSO elimination (NFA).
