Water Pollution Control Update

- **Plant**

- Annual flow meter calibrations are scheduled for June 4th and 5th.
- Facility toxicity analysis is scheduled for June 10th – 14th.
- WPC staff participated in public outreach career days, coordinated by ATech K-6 Career Education Coordinator Denise Miller.
 - 5/9 Rock Creek Elementary
 - 5/15 Jefferson Elementary
 - 5/17 Ridgeview Elementary
 - 5/22 Kingsville Elementary
- Exterior lighting repairs and replacement at the facility are ongoing.
- City Manager, WPC, and GPD met with Kinder Morgan to discuss ongoing efforts for the outfall relocation. GPD is currently working on surveying the property and obtaining topographical data to being design of the outfall.

- **Collection System**

- West 14th SSO elimination project – pipe and manholes installed. Contractor milled roadway in preparation for pavement replacement.
- Ohio Ave Extension Sewer Project – Easement has been cleared, temporary driveway installed, and gravity sewers with manholes are being installed. Project is ongoing.
- New vacuum pump installed at Minnesota storm water pumping station.
- Accessed and visually observed all the sanitary and storm manholes for the ODOT paving project on Lake Avenue and Route 84 / Main Ave. An itemized list of recommended manhole casting and lid replacements was provided to ODOT. There are provisions in the contract for the replacements.
- WPC worked with the City's Engineering Technician to create draft request for proposals (RFP) for sanitary and storm projects. The following RFP's were sent to Ms. Sanders at the City Manager's office, to be advertised for bid:
 - Scott Avenue Sewer Extension
 - 1510 Michigan Avenue Sanitary Lateral Replacement
 - 2115 West 10th Street Sanitary Lateral Replacement
 - 3221 Superior Avenue Storm Sewer Repair
 - 1527 West 19th Storm Sewer Repair and Catch Basin Replacement
- EnviroSight sewer inspection push camera is out for repair at Best Equipment in North Royalton.

- **Misc. –**

- GPD Study is still ongoing. This includes the short/long term capital improvement plan, sewer rate study, and SSO elimination (NFA).
