Water Pollution Control Update

- **Plant**

- Carl St. Angelo (WPC Maintenance Foreman) passed his OEPA Class I Wastewater Operator Certification exam on June 7th.
- DJE Engineering is installing new electrical service from the blower building to the UV building. Additional electrical service is required to accommodate the UV building AC units.
- Preventative maintenance and tank cleaning is underway.
- City Hall received communication for Findings and Orders dated 5/29/24 from OEPA Director Anne Vogel. Orders include digester #2 rehabilitation and SSO elimination schedule with NFA.
- Discharge Monitoring Report – Quality Assurance (DMR-QA) is currently underway for the WPC laboratory. This occurs once per year and is required by the USEPA Office of Compliance per Section 308 of the Clean Water Act. This study confirms accuracy of our in-house testing analysis. Testing results are graded by an accredited proficiency testing provider.
- Facility toxicity analysis and testing completed the week of June 10th – 14th.

- **Collection System**

- Ohio Ave Extension Sewer Project – Contractor is installing the force main with directional drill. Project is ongoing.
- 1525 West 19th – The catch basin replacement project is complete.
- 1205 Bridge St. – The sinkhole was investigated. The condition of the sewer line was confirmed. The excavation was backfilled and paved.

- **Misc. –**

- GPD Study is still ongoing. This includes the short/long term capital improvement plan, sewer rate study, and SSO elimination (NFA).
