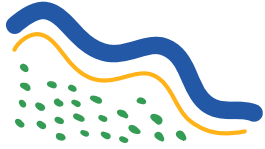

CAMPAIGN 2025 PROJECT LIST

Village of Jefferson

Parks and Recreation Playground • \$500,000

Development of a state-of-the-art inclusive destination playground at the former Memorial Field. A safe and engaging environment for both local families and visitors that will feature innovative and accessible equipment and activities.



Ashtabula Arts Center

Expansion and Renovation • \$400,000

Increase capacity to support artistic creativity, education and presentation through new classroom and rehearsal space and exterior improvements.



Conneaut Port Authority

Marina Infrastructure • \$114,000

Adding a gravity-fed sanitary system to facilitate expansion of marina space with addition of 40 new slips for larger vessels.



Ashtabula Area City Schools

Outdoor Learning Lab • \$100,000

Offering a unique learning environment for students and the community with creation of a natural outdoor classroom behind Erie Elementary School.



Conneaut Township Park

Pickleball Courts • \$75,000

Creating playing surfaces and spaces for one of America's fast-growing recreational sports with addition of four new courts to promote health and wellness for all ages.



Park Place Non-Profit Center

Main Avenue Pocket Park • \$75,000

The redevelopment of Downtown Ashtabula will include streetscape and façade improvements and a new pocket park for family-focused programming, picnic space and food truck areas.



Ashtabula County YMCA

Fitness Equipment and Amenities • \$55,000

Improving family engagement by adding new indoor cycling bikes, "big kids" tricycles, wagons, mini arcade basketball game and a flexi projector.



Geneva Little League

Carraher Field Complex • \$20,000

New drainage, outfield dirt and essential prepatory work will makeover the facility to provide a better environment for practices, games and tournaments.
