### 1329.03 PLACEMENT OF NUMBERS ON BUILDINGS.

In general, numbers shall be placed upon the center of the riser of the top step leading to a building. **Any building which abuts an alley or similar right of way shall also display in a clear and visible manner the certified building number, of not less than the size required by this Code, at the rear or side of the building closest to the alley or right of way.** Where this is impracticable, the location shall be determined by the City Engineer.
