Mary Graves called the meeting to order.

Approval of the August 2022 minutes was motioned by Margaret Distler and seconded by Ken Vanyo. Minutes were approved as written.

Guest Pete Bean from the My Neighborhood Collaborative gave an update on Safety Days. Safety Days will be held on September 17th, 2022 from Noon to 4:00 PM at Clifford Kadon Presidential Park.

Guest Larry Fargo gave an update on the fountain. There will be six panels when finished and two frameworks with donors names on them. There will also be a QR Code that will take people to the ADDA website that will explain all of the panels. Will contact when he has a date for a ribbon cutting ceremony.

Mary Graves gave the following officers report:

Mary Graves's term is up September 17th, 2022. Asks to be reappointed by city council at their convenience.

Coastal Management Assistance Grant - It was stated that the city has applied for and received this grant in the past. This years deadline is October 14, 2022.

Old business: Ashtabula Total Solar Eclipse Event – Mary Graves will be lead organizer and will be gearing up at the beginning of the new year to get a core group and volunteers for the event.

New business: Beach Mats for Walnut Beach. (All costs include installation from city)

- Access Trax has flat 36" x 36" x 1/8" with hinges. Each panel costs \$75 and 100 feet of panels would cost approximately \$3,500.
- Access Rec provides a teak roll-able beach walkway for \$79.96 per panel. 100 feet is estimated to be \$3,500
- Mobi-mat provides and 6.5 foot wide by 50 foot long wood like walkway. 100 feet is estimated to be \$5,000

Wheel chair accessible swings.

- WhisperGlide has an aluminum swing for two people. (One wheelchair and another bench for a companion.) Cost is \$6,795
- Rehabmart – Wheelchair Swing Platform and Frame by SportsPlay – Cost is \$1,260.00 each

Board members are disappointed that a garbage can has not been put out at the pickleball courts at Topkey.
