1501.21 SPRINKLER SYSTEM WATER SUPPLY

Commented [C1]: 1501.21 is entirely new language

a) ~~(a)~~ National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 13 “Standard for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems” 2016 edition, is adopted as a referenced standard by the Ohio Fire Code and by Ashtabula Codified Ordinance 1501.01(b).

b) The adopted Ohio Fire Code sprinkler design standard NFPA 13, 2016 edition, regarding combined fire and non-fire water supply piping is hereby revised as stated herein.

c) ~~(b)~~ For the purposes of this Section, the term “Fire Main” is that pipe and appurtenances between a source of water and the base of the system riser for water based fire protection systems or the base elbow of private fire hydrants.

~~(c) National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 13 “Standard for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems” 2016 edition, is adopted as a referenced standard by the Ohio Fire Code and by Ashtabula Codified Ordinance 1501.01(b).~~

d) ~~(c)~~ The City of Ashtabula deletes in its entirety Section 24.1.3.3 of NFPA 13 “Standard for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems” 2016 edition.

~~NFPA 13 (2016) 24.1.3.3 Where a single main less than 4 in. (100 mm) in diameter serves both fire systems and other uses, the non-fire demand shall be added to the hydraulic calculations for the fire system at the point of connection unless provisions have been made to automatically isolate the non-fire demand during a fire event.~~

Commented [C2]: Verbiage from NFPA standard, included for reference only, need not be included in Codified Ordinance language

e) ~~(d)~~ The City of Ashtabula amends NFPA 13 as follows; the City of Ashtabula requires that all Fire Mains be connected directly to the water supply source without any taps, tees or other connections for non-fire use.
